Sof davar...

Rav Ada bar Ahava, the first of our *amoraim* to be featured on *sof davar*, was an *amora* who overlapped the first and second generations of *amoraim*, shortly after the year 200. He was born, interestingly, on the very day that R.Yehudah haNassi died. He was a student of Rav and his strength lay in *halacha*, not in *aggada*. Rav Ada was a very pious and humble individual and became widely-known as a *chasid* (not in present day terms). More interesting was the fact that he was considered a *baal mofeis* for whom miracles often were performed. It was said that Rav Huna had quite a large number of barrels of wine that were being stored in a building that was on the verge of collapse. Everyone was afraid to enter the building to get the wine for fear that it would collapse upon them. Rav Huna then devised a plan and called Rav Ada bar Ahava to come and "discuss learning" with him. Confident that the building would not collapse on Rav Ada, Rav Huna engaged him in learning in the shaky structure, all the while his workers were removing all the barrels of wine. The task completed they exited the building and no sooner did they leave the building that it collapsed. On another occasion a fast was declared because of a severe drought. Rav Ada came to join in the fast and when he took off his first shoe drops of rain began to fall. By the time he took off his second shoe it began to pour. Truly a *baal mofeis* was Rav Ada bar Ahavah.
