Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: Abayei

If you consider a "probeh" by a rabbi for a rabbinical position difficult consider the position of the four great scholars who were vying for the post as head of the world famous yeshiva in Pumpedissa. The officials decided that each candidate would present a dvar halacha and the one whose dvar halacha could not be challenged would be selected for that position. The divrei Torah of Rabbah, R. Zeira and Rabbah bar Masnah were successfully refuted. But not that of the fourth candidate, Abayei. His selection as head of the yeshiva of Pumpedissa was the culmination of a long and spectacular career as a talmid chacham of the first rank and as leader among his people. His life started on a tragic note as he never knew his parents. His father died when his mother was pregnant and his mother passed away at childbirth. His real name was Nachmeini and he was a descendant of Eili hakohen. He gave great honor to the woman who raised him, often quoting her in the gemara with the opening phrase "amra li eim" (my mother said). A student of Rabbah and Rav Yosef, Abayei became one of the most distinguished of the fourth generation amoraim. His respect for Rav Yosef was such that he declared that he would stand in his honor as soon as he saw the ears of Rav Yosef's donkey in the distance. Abayei's disputes with Rava, his good friend, are legendary. Unfortunately for Abayei his views were adopted as halacha only six times.
