LOCAL ERUV

Sof davar...

by Rabbi Israel Poleyeff Tannaim and Amoraim: Issi ben Yehudah

The medrash says that Moshe Rabbeinu had seven different names. Issi ben Yehuda a fifth century tanna, comes close with six different names. (Keep in mind that the name Issi is often synonymous with Yosi or Yosef). Issi came from the town of Hutzal, so it is no surprise that he would be known as (1) Yosef Ish Hutzal. Now the town of Hutzal was located in Bavel. So it was quite natural for him to also be called (2) Yosef haBavli. The name by which he was most popularly known was (3) Issi ben Yehudah, and since in Yaakov's berachot to his children recorded in parshat Vayechi Yaakov refers to Yehudah as "gur aryeh Yehudah", Issi's fourth name was, guess... (4) Issi ben Gur Aryeh. Not finished yet. In the Yerushalmi he is referred to as (5) Yossi Katantah. (Could he have been small in physical stature?) So after all that what was his real name? That would be his sixth name and it was (6) Issi ben Akaviah. But by whatever name he was known he was acknowledged as a superior talmid chacham whose pronouncements, though not found in the mishna itself, is found extensively in the braitot and in the gemara. Although he was born in Bavel he went to study in Eretz Yisroel where he was one of the top students of Elazar ben Shamua. One of his most well-known statements is in the gemara. Yoma where he states that five passages in the Torah have no hechra. That is, they cannot be grammatically structured; we cannot establish for a certainty, exactly how these passages are divided. So well respected was Issi ben Yehudah that when he passed away it was said that "posku chassidim", the era of chassidim had come to an end. You don't say something like that about an ordinary scholar, and Issi was no ordinary talmid chacham. He was among the best.
