<u>A MESSAGE FROM RABBI LUBAN</u> <u>RE: PRUZBOL</u>

The Torah states that at the end of the shmittah year, all debts are cancelled. However, for various reasons, Hillel the Elder instituted a legal loophole known as pruzbol, whereby the debt is transferred to a beth din. The beth din is not a person, and is therefore not subject to the laws of debt cancellation. This year is a shmittah year. Unless one writes a pruzbol, all debts will be cancelled this Rosh Hashona. I will be available to prepare pruzbols for the next few Sundays after 7:15, 8:00 and 9:00 minyan (the minyanim end approximately 7:45, 8:35 and 9:35). If you cannot personally come to shul at these times, please contact me and I will act as your agent to execute a pruzbol for you. Please note that both men and women should perform a pruzbol if they have

Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Oshia

Very often the gemara will use a "nickname" in identifying a tanna or an amora. So if you come across the title "Oshia zeira d'min chevraya" know that they are referring to the famous R. Oshia, a third century amora, whom we meet so often. He was the brother of Chanina and the two of them were inseparable throughout their lives. R. Oshua was born in Bavel/Iraq (year unknown) where he was the student of Rav Huna. He did not remain in Bavel very long leaving with his brother for Eretz Yisroel where he remained the rest of his life. The two brothers settled in Yerushalayim where R, Oshia earned his living as a shoemaker (sometimes to some disreputable people). This did not prevent him from mixing with the leading scholars of the day. Some of his colleagues were R. Ami, R. Assi and R. Zayro. R. Yochanan was the leading scholar of that era in Israel and he felt that R. Oshia and R. Chanina both deserved to receive semicha. For some reason this did not work out and R. Yochanon was very much upset at this circumstance. R. Oshia comforted him by telling him that he and his bother are descendants of the house of Eli HaKohen. It was Eli whose sons, as recorded in tanach, were so wicked that a curse was placed on the family: "Lo yihiyeh zaken bevaisecho kol hayamim", a curse that declared that no descendant of the house Eli will live till an old age. Not having received semicha R. Oshia was given the prestigious title of "chaver", a term acclaiming them as great scholars. As for me a gadol like R. Oshia can be my chaver (in the literal sense, friend) any time.
