I must say however that I was wonderfully surprised at the great strides that the shul has made with regard to decorum in davening. I don't know if it's easy or hard to tell the difference when you're there every week, but to me the difference was striking, both during leining and also mussaf. In addition, I thought that the idea that a baal habus got up and spoke was very powerful. I give you and your decorum committee kudos for the energy and effort that goes into this longterm effort to change the culture of davening.
