Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Elazar b. Shamua

R. Elazar ben Shamua, a *talmid chacham* of distinction and a fourth generation *tanna*, was sandwiched between two giants of talmudic history. He was the student of R. Akiva and the teacher of R. Yehudah haNassi, two scholars of great renown. He wasone of the five survivors recorded in a well-known talmudic story of Roman oppression. Defying a Roman decree forbidding the study of Torah at the pain of death, R.Yehuda ben Bava took 5 students to an open field where he gave them *semicha*. They were spotted by the Romans, however, and all but R. Yehudah were able to flee. One of those five was R. Elazar ben Shamua. His love for Eretz Yisroel was legendary as illustrated by the story of R. Elazar and a colleague who decided to go to a yeshiva in Netzivim to learn. But when they reached the border of Israel they could go no further and turned back and returned home. A fascinating *agada* is related about R. Elazar ben Shamua. It seems he was strolling along the shores of the Mediterranean when he saw a ship break up and sink. There was only one survivor and he came ashore with no clothes. Everyone on shore ignored him and refused him any assistance. R. Elazar, appalled at what he saw, removed one of his cloaks and covered the man. He then took him home where he fed him, clothed him, gave him some money and accompanied him out of town. Years later this lone survivor became a Roman emperor who imposed severe decrees upon the Jews. R. Elazar was asked to lead a delegation to speak to the emperor on behalf of the Jews. As soon as he arrived he was recognized by the emperor. In recognition of the kindness shown to him years earlier the emperor declared that he will fulfill all of R. Elazar's requests. A nice *agada*. R. Elazar was known to have great love for his students as reflected in one of his most famous pronouncements: "*yehi kevod talmidecha keshelcha*" - May the honor of your students be as dear to you as your own. A great motto for every teacher.
