ACTION ALERT: Call Congress Now, Save **Jewish Day Schools and Yeshivas Millions**

A message from the OU and Agudath Israel of America: The Congressional leadership has chosen to appropriate \$14 billion for 'green' school modernization and repair projects as part of an \$825 billion stimulus bill to help jump start the economy. This 'green' funding is designed to serve the dual purpose of upgrading the nation's schools into appropriate learning environments that ultimately save money and immediately put people to work. Despite a concerted effort to demonstrate an equal spending need in America's non-public schools, the U.S. Congress has chosen exclusion. If every yeshiva and day school parent calls their Senator and Congressman, there will be tens of thousands of calls. The number to call the U.S. Congress is (202) 225-3121. Ask to be connected to the office of Congressman Frank Pallone and Senator Frank Lautenberg and simply say that you are calling to ask the senator or congressman to "Include the nation's nonpublic schools in the economic stimulus package." If you reach a voicemail message, please do not hang up! Stay on the line and leave a message after the tone. Congressional offices track exactly how many people call on each issue and every single call makes a difference. Please! We need your help to achieve equal treatment of non-public schools.

Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Eliezer ben Hyrcanus

Whenever the name R. Eliezer appears in the *gemara* it refers to R. Eliezer b. Hyrcanus. He was the student of the illustrious R. Yochanan ben Zaccai. In his youth he was an exceptional student. It is related that on a very rainy day the *bet havaad* – the chief tribunal - chose not to meet. The children, gleefully probably, decided to convene their own *bet havad*, imitating their elders. As it turned out all of them, R. Eliezer among them, became great scholars. R. Eliezer had a tough personality and often refused to bow to the majority viewpoint as expressed by his colleagues. As an example, after the *churban bayit sheni* the sanhedrin wanted to set high standards of religious practice. R. Eliezer refused to join them. This greatly upset his colleagues and it began a series of events that led to his estrangement from his colleagues and eventually to his excommunication. Even after a famous incident recorded in the *genara* when, miraculously, a carob tree, a stream of water and the walls of the *bet medrash* indicated support for his view his former friends would not take him back. He never returned to Yavneh again. An *agada* relates that R. Eliezer was once walking in the market place when a woman, cleaning her home, dumped a pile of garbage on his head. He saw this as a good sign. Quoting the passage *me-ashpot yorim evyon* (from the trash heap he lifts the destitute) he felt he would now be taken back by his friends. It was not to be. The estrangement was complete. It is further related that his wife believed that if R. Eliezer would perform *nefilat apayim* in the *davening* some evil would befall her brother Rabban Gamliel. Daily she watched her husband and prevented him from *nefilat apayim*. One day she believed it was *rosh chodesh* when no *tachanun* is said. So she let down her guard. She was mistaken, however. It was an ordinary day and her husband performed *nefilat apayim*. On that day, it was said, Rabban Gamliel passed from this world. It was only after his passing that R. Eliezer b. Hyrcan
