Rabbi Aaron Chomsky, zt"l

A little over two weeks ago an unassuming, modest man came into our shul and joined us in tefilla. It did not take long before we learned that this was Rabbi Aaron Chomsky whose humility hid the fact that here was a rabbi of long standing and a scholar of some distinction. Rabbi Chomsky had just moved into our neighborhood and it was with pride that we welcomed him into our shul. He was short in stature but tall in his achievements and accomplishments.

An early student in RJJ and a musmach of Yeshivas Rabbeinu Yitzchak Elchanan, Rabbi Chomsky's rabbinic career spanned more than 50 years. The last of his positions was in neighboring Perth Amboy. He guided his congregations with love and compassion and earned the reputation of being a truly caring rabbi. He was more than a rabbi. He was a guide and a counselor to countless people.

Rabbi Chomsky was assisted in his work by his incomparable rebbetzin, Lillian o"h, and together carved out a niche in rabbinic service for others to emulate. His children are remarkable in the way they fulfilled the mitzvah of kibbud av ve-aim.

Rabbi Chomsky, a good friend of mine for several decades told me that he was planning to get fully involved in our shul and in RPRY in whatever way possible. Sadly, this was not to be as he was taken to the yeshiva shel maalah on 29 Tammuz (July 21).

Rabbi Chomsky was here for but a short time but his ever present smile and gentle personality will not let us forget that we had a great man in our midst, if only for a few weeks.
