If you cannot get through to a live operator, you may leave a message. There is just a week left before the inauguration of the president-elect and this is the time when sitting presidents frequently grant pardons. We have heard that most of the calls requesting Mr. Pollard's release are from the tri-State region, indicating to the White House that this is a regional, and not a national issue. For such reason, we urge you to ask your friends and relatives who live outside New York, New Jersey and Connecticut to place calls on his behalf, as well. THERE ARE ONLY DAYS LEFT!

# by Rabbi Israel Poleyeff Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Elazar ben Arach

The life of R. Elazar ben Arach presents us with a curious enigma. He was a second generation *tanna* who was a student of the illustrious Yochanan ben Zaccai. He was among his very best students as evidenced by the fact that his rebbi described him (in pirkei avos) as a maayan hamitgaber – a spring growing stronger and stronger. Abba Shaul even added that on a balance scale R. Elazar b. Arach would outweigh all the other scholars combined. So great was his scholarship that he was one of the very few who was able to analyze and interpret the maaseh hamerkavah – the enigmatic events of Ezekiel's vision of heavenly chariots and other mystical entities. With the passing of R. Yochanan ben Zaccai R. Elazar's life took a curious turn. He did not join his colleagues and return to Yavneh. Instead he followed the advice of his wife and left for Emmaus, a place of bath houses and frivolity. Alone and far from his friends and colleagues he gradually forgot all that he had learned explaining, perhaps, why such a great scholar left so little of his pronouncements in the talmud. One *agada* even goes so far as to say that he even forgot *kriat haTorah* and could not read the passage *hachodesh hazeh lochem* correctly. Some use him as the perfect example of what happens to someone who leaves a *makom torah* for a location devoid of Torah life. But yet another *agada* has Eliyahu haNavi coming to him and restoring all his lost knowledge. R. Elazar ben Arach, a life lived on two differing ends of society.
