OPEN LETTER TO SHUL COMMUNITY:

The news is filled with reports about the deepening recession in the U.S. and rising unemployment rates. Our community is certainly not insulated from the recession and too many of our neighbors are victims of job cuts and some are now struggling with maintaining their critical needs, such as food, heat, and maintaining a roof over their head. Unfortunately, it is anticipated that the economic problems may even get worse before they get better.
