Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: Bruriah

OK, she never was an a*mora* or a *tanna* but she often discussed *halachic* issues with the *tannaim* of her generation. With those credentials she has earned a *sof davar* all her own. Bruriah was recognized as a *chachamah* and a *melumedess*, a wise and learned woman. One account has it that she learned 300 *halachot* from 300 scholars in 3 years. She not only discussed *halacha* with great sages but they sometimes made their halachic decisions based on her views. The most famous story in the gemara about her involves her husband R. Meir who wanted to offer prayers that a band of unruly gangsters in their neighborhood simply die. Bruriah, however, reminded her husband that the passage reads that sins (*chataim*) be wiped out, not sinners (*chotim*). R. Meir acknowledging her perceptiveness, offered *tefilot* that they do *teshuva* (and they did). Bruriah's family life, however, was filled with tragedy. Her father, R.Chananya ben Teradyon will be recognized as one of the *asara harugei malchus*, one of the ten great martyrs. Her mother was also killed by the Romans. Her sister was forced into a *bet zenus* and her brother also was martyred by the Romans during the uprising. In her own family two of her young sons died on a s*habbat* day and she withheld the information from her husband till nightfall in order not to disturb his *Shabbat* rest. Perhaps the finest memorial to this outstanding woman is the thousands of fine young ladies who study in all the various yeshivot and especially those who have graduated or who attend the yeshiva named in her honor.
