Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Chiya

Born in Kafri in Bavel (modern Iraq), R. Chiya was among the last of the tannaim (about 200 c.e.). When he was able to he left Bavel for Eretz Yisroel then under the control of the Romans. He became a *ben bayis* at the home of the *nasi*. His vast scholarship was recognized by the *nasi* and R. Chiya was given very important responsibilities, such as *Kiddush hachodesh*, establishing the calendar, an extremely important task in those days. So great was his scholarship that he and R. Oshia together finalized some of the early *mishnayos*. R. Chiya would probably feel very comfortable in our day since he was known as a *machmir*. For example, R. Oshia constructed an *eruv* (for his daughter-in-law, some say) but R. Chiya promptly declared it invalid. R. Chiya was very much concerned about the education of children and was appalled to learn that they did not have sufficient *seforim*. He promptly proceeded to correct the situation by catching deer (or said he would), making parchment from their skins,then writing each of the *chumashim* on five different sections of parchment. Then he divided the children into five groups, taught each group one of the *chumashim* and instructed them to teach their part to the other four groups. In this way he was able to spread Torah in Israel and saw to it that it would not be lost. R. Chiya was blessed with two sons, Yehudah and Chizkiah, who themselves were acknowledged *gedolim* in Torah and good deeds. So well respected were they that it was said that if Eliyahu haNavi was to be asked who can be considered *tzadikim* equal to our *avos* he would **respond "R. Chiya and his children". Not bad.**
