ORTHODOX FORUM

The Orthodox Forum presents the final lecture of the 2008-2009 season on Motzei Shabbat March 7, 2009, 8:30 pm at Congregation Ahavas Achim - 216 South 1st Ave, Highland Park, NJ. The guest speaker is RABBI MARC D. ANGEL, Rabbi Emeritus of Congregation Shearith Israel, NY.

To illustrate the topic of Leadership Issues and Ideological Tensions within Orthodoxy, Rabbi Angel will role-play the fictional search for a Rosh Yeshiva. One candidate is the yeshiva bochur son of the late rosh yeshiva, and the other is a university graduate. We, the audience, playing the part of the virtual Search Committee, will hear and weigh Rabbi Angel's presentation of the varying viewpoints. The presentation is fictional but in reality many of the arguments on either side are currently being played out on the communal and personal levels.

Rabbi Angel has won acclaim for his studies in Jewish history and thought. He is the author or editor of 26 books, most recently including Choosing to Be Jewish: The Orthodox Road to Conversion, Foundations of Sephardic Spirituality: The Inner Life of Jews of the Ottoman Empire," and a novel, THE SEARCH COMMITTEE. He has been active in a wide range of communal organizations and is past president of the RCA. He and Rabbi Avi Weiss founded the International Rabbinic Fellowship, a worldwide association of Modern Orthodox rabbis.
