Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: Rav Yudan

What? You never heard of Rav Yudan? Well, no wonder. He does not appear in *bavli* even once. But this fourth generation *amora* from Eretz Yisroel does appear in numerous *medrashim* and earned the title as the *baal agada*, the master of the *agada*. Many of his medrashim were aimed at alleviating the plight of his fellow Jews suffering under the heavy rule of Rome. Among those *medrashim* was one of his most famous. It tells of a mother who was crying profusely when her daughter was giving birth. Her neighbors inquired as to why she was crying. Was it because of happiness? It is more than that, she replied. If my daughter is suffering should I not cry? In similar fashion, Rav Yudan continued, when the people of Israel suffer Hashem suffers along with his children. Nonetheless Rav Yudan was an optimistic person, and when Caeser Yulianus (Julius?) was emperor he firmly believed in the imminent coming of the *geula*. He preached that the *geula* will come like the rising sun: slowly but assuredly. That was Rav Yudan and now you can't say you never heard of him.
