Sof davar...

Tannaim and Amoraim: R. Yochanan haSandlor

This third generation *tanna* with the odd nickname lived about the year 150 and was one of R. Akiva's better students. Once, when R. Akiva was jailed by the Romans, a halachic question arose as to whether a *chalitza* performed privately by two people not in the presence of a *bet din* was valid. No one knew the answer and there was no way of communicating with R. Akiva. R. Yochanan took matters into his own hands and dressed up as a traveling merchant. He walked the streets calling out the merchandise he had for sale. As he passed the jail he called out: "Who needs pins? *Chalitza* between two people what is it?" R. Akiva heard him and understood his plan. He responded "Do you have a spindle? Kasher". Thus they got the answer to their question. R. Yochanan loved Eretz Yisroel and declared that living in Israel is comparable to fulfilling all the *mitzvos* of the Torah. Once, he wanted to go to Bavel to study Torah but could not get himself to cross the border and leave Israel. On another occasion after the Roman decrees against the Jews were rescinded R. Yochanan and other students of R. Akiva gathered for the purpose of declaring a leap year. At that conference a bitter argument broke out between R. Yochanan and R. Meir. However, they did not leave that location until they resolved their dispute and kissed. It may have been from that gathering that R. Yochanan made his famous statement found in Pirkei Avos: "Any gathering that is dedicated to *shem shomayim* – for the sake of heaven – will endure. Those that are not shall not endure". Oh, as to his nickname haSandlor, could it be that he was a *sandlor*, a shoemaker? Possibly. But one source suggests that the name is a corruption of the name of the city of Alexandria. He was given that name because R. Yochanan haSandlor was born in the city of Alexandria in Egypt. We leave it to you to decide.
