# by Rabbi Israel Poleyeff, Research by Susan Wolf Jewish Sports Standouts (3): Dimitry Salita

Dimitriy was born in the Ukraine to a family devoid of all Jewish practices. They did, however, know they were Jewish because of the anti-Semitism all around them. His family moved to Brooklyn when he was 9. At the urging of his brother he started boxing in Starrett City. It was in the years following that Dimitriy became interested in orthodox Judaism and slowly added mitzvos into his life. At 17 he entered the Golden Gloves boxing tournament in New York and made it to the finals where he lost. By this time he became fully Orthodox and attributed his successes to his observance of torah and mitzvos. He entered a tournament in Mississippi where he won match after match and was scheduled to box in the finals on a Saturday. He told the coordinators of the event that he could not box on Saturday because of his religious beliefs. The officials realized that their championship match would mean nothing without Salita so they changed the day, and Salita won. Now a full fledged orthodox Jew, Salita turned pro and is presently the welterweight champion of the world or the leading contender for that crown. Dimitriy Salita might be the only orthodox Jew to climb the ropes into a boxing ring and he has brought pride to the Jewish community. For more information on Salita talk to Elie Borger right now.
