# Sof davar...

#### Amoraim: R. Yochanan

# by Rabbi Israel Poleyeff

Unquestionably R. Yochanan ranks among one of the top three *amoraim* ever in the talmudic period. He lived in Eretz Yisroel in the 200s. His early life was difficult. His father, Nafcha, died when his mother was pregnant and his mother died in childbirth. He was raised by his grandfather and studied under Rebbi in the yeshiva in Tziporei. R. Yehuda haNassi predicted that he would become among the *gedolei hador*. His life was made more difficult by the deaths of all ten of his sons in his lifetime. Yet he persisted in his learning and teaching of Torah. R. Yochanan established a yeshiva in Tveriah which soon gained the reputation of being an outstanding yeshiva. His most famous student was his son-in-law, Reish Lakish. R. Yochanan's name and reputation grew rapidly until his "torah" was considered the norm. His *maamorim* in *halacha* are found everywhere throughout both talmudim, *bavli* and *yerushalmi*. He set many rules for the study of *halacha*. For example, if you have an anonymous statement (*stam*) followed by a dispute on the same subject the *halacha* does not follow the *stam*. If the situation is reversed and a dispute is followed by *stam* then the *halacha* does follow the view of the *stam*. Similarly, the *halacha* always follows an anonymous *mishna*. It was R. Yochanan who gave us the account of kamtza and bar kamtza that led to the destruction of the *bais hamikdosh*. He was respectful of all human beings including non Jews and would often stand in the presence of an aged non Jew. R. Yochanan was also knowledgeable in the field of medicine and recommended that one should not drink water that was not previously boiled. With the passing of Rav and Shmuel he became the single undisputed leader in both Eretz Yisroel and in Bavel, a status he held until his passing in 279.
