Dear Member,

The traffic and parking situation around RPRY and COT has reached a critical and potentially dangerous situation. Tuesday morning, traffic was tied up for 15-20 minutes in each direction due to the heavy traffic and snow-related issues. In addition, due to the fact that cars were illegally parked in front of the shul, the buses were not able to turn thereby further exacerbating a bad situation. Finally, cars from our members are routinely parked in front of our garbage and in neighbor driveways. We are asking for your help and assistance to make this situation better.

Please do NOT park in any Fire Lanes or block any fire hydrants or driveways. The Edison Police Department is aware of the violations that routinely occur around the RPRY/COT facilities and, given the dangerous conditions, intend to enforce all traffic and parking laws around the two facilities. Therefore, if you park in the fire lanes or block the fire hydrants or driveways around the school area you should fully expect to be ticketed. This is expected to be enforced at all times of the day beginning Wednesday, February 2nd.

RPRY has sent out a similar email to its parent body and together we hope to make this situation more workable. Longer term solutions are also being discussed.
