How about this: A young girl, a Shomeret Shabbat, a junior in a prominent college in Ohio, who was so good that they scheduled their practices to fit into her religious schedule. They even made some adjustments in the regular schedule to accommodate her beliefs. Who is this person? Her name is Naama Shafir. She was born in Hoshaya in the Galil in Israel, the fourth of 9 children and is now 21 years old. She plays basketball for the University of Toledo. It is believed she is the first orthodox Jew to play in the NCAA. Toledo gave her a basketball scholarship and was well rewarded for their decision. In 2011 she led Toledo to the finals of the women's NIT and then scored 40 points in the championship game to lead Toledo to their first ever championship in school history. For her exploits she earned the MVP award of the tournament. As a special reward for the team, the Rockets went on a tour of Israel. Most of the players had never been outside the United States. They made all the usual tourist stops including the Kotel on Friday night and also visited with Naama's family. In addition they played basketball against different women's teams in the country. She is only a junior, so maybe she'll transfer to Stern for her senior year. The basketball team would like that.
