SHABBOS GUIDELINES FOR SNOW

- You must judge if it is safe for you to go to shul.
- -Snow is not muktzah.
 - -Making a path in snow is not prohibited on Shabbos. However, shoveling snow is an issue of *tircha yisaira*(excessive excertion) which is not permitted on Shabbos unless there is an element of danger (i.e. icy sidewalks or danger for the elderly). Of course, if the eruv is down, snow cannot be shoveled in any event.
- -Making snowballs or snowpeople on Shabbos falls in the category of Boneh which is not permitted.
 - -It is permissible to spread salt or Ice Melt on snow or ice on Shabbos.
 - -If there are power outages in the area, one must be concerned that the eruv is down, and carrying should be suspended. We hope this storm will not be like Hurricane Sandy. May we see the fulfillment of, "Ulichol B'nai Yisrael hoyo ohr bimoshvosom"

(And for all the children of Israel there was light in their dwellings). (Shemos 10:23) Have a wonderful Shabbos.
