YOM YERUSHALAYIM SHABBAT **WEEKEND**

In celebration of Yom Yerushalayim, Ohr Torah will host Rabbi Steven Weil, Senior Managing Director of the Orthodox Union, who will serve as guest lecturer. In addition to the Shabbat morning Derasha at the main Minyan, Rabbi Weil will speak Shabbos afternoon at the home of Shoshana and Brian Allen, 34 Leslie St. at 5:30 pm.
