### **PRUZBAL**

The Torah mandates that outstanding loans cannot be collected at the end of the Shmitah year, which is observed every seven years. Since we are now approaching the end of a Shmitah year, loans will soon be nullified this coming Rosh Hashana. The Rabbis provided a legal method to maintain loans by executing a Pruzbal document. The Pruzbal transfers the loans to a Bais Din, and in that way, the loan remains collectible.

I will be available in shul for the next three Sundays, August 23, 30 and September 6, after each of the three Sunday morning Minyanim ( which conclude approximately 7:45, 8:30 and 9:30 AM), to help you execute a Pruzbal.
