PRUZBAL

The Torah mandates that outstanding loans cannot be collected at the end of the Shmitah year, which is observed every seven years. Since we are now approaching the end of a Shmitah year, loans will soon be nullified this coming Rosh Hashana. The Rabbis provided a legal method to maintain loans by executing a Pruzbal document. The Pruzbal transfers the loans to a Bais Din, and in that way, the loan remains collectible.

I will be available in shul for the next two Sundays, August 30th and September 6th, after each of the two Sunday morning Minyanim (which conclude approximately 7:45, 8:30 and 9:30AM), to help you execute a Pruzbal.
