It is uncertain what track Hurricane Joaquin will take. If, Chas V'shalom, it moves in our

direction, there is a chance that we may sustain very high winds. Most Sukkos cannot withstand intense winds, and flying Sukkah pieces may become dangerous projectiles, imperiling people's safety.

In the event that our neighborhood experiences high winds there may be a need to dismantle our Sukkos before Shemini Atzeres. Almost always, safety overrides other concerns of Mitzvah observance. We will keep you posted and make recommendations as needed.

We also may experience power outages and flooding. As the needs present themselves, we will share practical and Halachic recommendations.

We hope Be'ezras Hashem the storm will not affect us and we will experience a pleasant and serene Yom Tov.

ISRAELI ESROGIM AND SHEVI'IS Please note that if you purchased an Israeli Esrog this year, it has Kedushas Sheviis, which means it has special sanctity since it grew during a Shemita year, and the Esrog may not be discarded immediately after Sukkos.

It is preferable to return the Esrog to Israel after Sukkos. Rabbi Shimoni has graciously offered to send Esrogim back to Israel. You may bring your Esrog to his store, Highland Park Judaica, at the corner of 3rd Ave. and Raritan Ave. You may do so whether or not you purchased your Esrog from his store. Please bring you Esrog in to the store as soon as possible.
