#### R. Gedaliah Felder (1921-1991)

One of the leading Rabbonim in Canada during the latter decades of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, who was often consulted in matters of Halacha by communities throughout North America was Rabbi Gedaliah Felder. Born in Galicia in 1921, Gedaliah Felder was 15 years old in 1936, when he left Europe with his family to join his father in Montreal. After studying with private tutors and attending yeshivas in Montreal and Toronto, notably Yeshiva Torat Chaim headed by a notable Talmud Chacham, Rabbi Abraham Price, R. Felder received Semicha in 1940. After serving as a pulpit rabbi in several small Ontario communities, Rabbi Felder moved to Toronto in 1949 to become Principal of the Bais Yehuda Talmud Torah. Shortly thereafter, he was appointed pulpit rabbi of Congregation Shomrai Shabboth, where he remained for the rest of his life.

During the 1950s, it became increasingly clear that Rabbi Felder was not only a person of great integrity but possessed considerable erudition. Though still a young man in his 30's, his opinion on matters of Jewish law came to be held in high esteem. R. Felder was constantly consulted on local issues of Jewish law, and increasingly his halachic opinion was requested by Jews throughout Canada and the United States. His literary legacy to this day is still regarded as an important resource for many rabbis. His multi volume work, *Yesodei Yeshurun*, along with *Nachalat Zvi, Pri Yeshurun, She'elat Yeshurun*, a work of Responsa, and numerous essays in rabbinic journals on topics of Jewish law and Talmud commentary remain highly regarded by rabbinic experts.

For many years, Rabbi Felder served as the leading Posek for the Kashruth Division of Canadian Jewish Congress, or COR, the leading symbol of kashrut in Canada to this day. In addition, while many communities now have an eruv to facilitate carrying on Shabbos, as early as the 1950s, Rabbi Felder took responsibility for supporting a local eruv in Toronto, one of the first Jewish communities in North America to have a Halachically approved eruv. Following a serious stroke, Rabbi Felder spent several years in a wheelchair before his death on December 30, 1991, at the age of 70. One of his sons remains pulpit rabbi of Cong. Shomrai Shabboth, where his father had served for many decades.
