Despite the recent efforts (and success) of the Highland Park First Aid Squad, in answering daytime calls (without having to call in another agency), the town has decided that <u>effectively immediately</u> all daytime first aid calls will automatically be answered by a paid service. This was not up for discussion and will be in effect <u>seven days a week</u>. Therefore, anyone who calls 9-1-1 during the day (including weekends) will not be getting a Highland Park ambulance. Instead they will be getting a paid ambulance and a bill for somewhere around \$1500 - \$2000.

The First Aid Squad intends to address this at the next borough council meeting (this Tuesday, 6/12/18 at 7:00 pm). Anyone who is interested, concerned, or wishes to show support for the squad is encouraged to attend.
