RPRY SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT

With school starting this week, it is important to note the following rules regarding parking near OT/RPRY:

• The carpool lane on Edgemount Road, including the front of the playground and trailer, must remain completely clear during arrival and

dismissal. Please do not park there. This includes during morning and evening minyanim at OT. • Parking is prohibited in the fire zone next to OT or anywhere there are yellow lines. Don't park there. Even if you are running late for minyan or just need to run in for 5 minutes, still don't park there.

• Parking is prohibited in front of the OT dumpsters. Do not block this area.

Please drive slowly, do not use a cell phone while driving, and be very aware of children walking to and from their cars and the school.
Please do not back up or make a K-Turn or U-turn during arrival or dismissal on Edgemount or Harrison.

• Please do not park in front of the Yeshiva during school hours, on either side of Harrison Street. Rather, please use a legal parking spot.

Text Messages: Don't have a Smartphone or don't want to use Twitter? Get alerts via text. This involves setting up a Twitter account, but once setup, you can ignore your Twitter account. It gives you immediate alerts without Twitter blather. **Facebook:** Facebook group @hperuv that gets updated when we update Twitter account.
