LOCAL ERUV: We have six official ways of alerting you to eruy's status. Be aware and find out eruy status every week before Shabbat and Chaggim.

'Twitter: Eruv's official alerts are sent out via Twitter.Follow @hp_eruv on Twitter Get updates about eruv's status as it's been determined.

Text Messages: Don't have a Smartphone or don't want to use Twitter? Get alerts via text. This involves setting up a Twitter account, but once setup, you can ignore your Twitter account. It gives you immediate alerts without Twitter blather.

Facebook: Facebook group @hperuv that gets updated when we update Twitter account, Follow Facebook group (don't just "Like" it), and you'll get alerts about the eruv's status via Facebook. 'Email: Go to http://hperuv.org and sign up for the email list. The email list checks the eruv's status after 3pm once per hour and sends out an email with updates.
