## **TISHA B'AV HALACHOS**

-Shalosh Seudos should be eaten Shabbos afternoon after Mincha. One may drink wine and eat meat at this meal. Shalosh Seudos must be concluded by 8:02 PM.

-Tisha B'av evening (Saturday night), the fast begins at 8:02 PM. One must remove one's shoes at home at 8:52 PM. Before doing so, and also before doing Melacha, one must say Boruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lechol. After changing shoes, one should light the Havdalah candle and only recite the Bracha of Borei Me'orei Ha'aish. At that point, one may change into weekday clothes. Maariv will take place at 9:30 PM followed by Eicha. It is not necessary to bring sneakers to Shul before Shabbos.

-Sunday evening, the fast ends at 8:51 PM. Before one eats, Havdalah must be recited. It is permissible to drink wine for Havdalah. One does not make a Bracha on the candle or Besamim at this time. One should not eat meat, drink wine (except for Havdalah) or listen to music until Monday morning. Sunday night after the fast is over, one may bathe, take a haircut, shave, and do laundry.

'Twitter: Eruv's official alerts are sent out via Twitter.Follow @hp\_eruv on Twitter Get updates about eruv's status as it's been determined. 'Text Messages: Don't have a Smartphone or don't want to use Twitter? Get alerts via text. This involves setting up a Twitter account, but once setup, you can ignore your Twitter account. It gives you immediate alerts without Twitter blather. **Facebook**: Facebook group @hperuv that gets updated when we update Twitter account. Follow Facebook group (don't just "Like" it), and you'll get alerts about the eruv's status via Facebook. •Email: Go to http://hperuv.org and sign up for the email list. The email list checks the eruv's status after 3pm once per hour and sends out an email with updates.
