Paltiel (Phillip) Birnbaum (1904-1988)

Prior to the success of the Art Scroll Siddur, most of us, over 50 years of age, remember the Birnbaum siddur. Well! Who was Birnbaum? Paltiel Birnbaum was born in Kielce, Poland in 1904. He was 19 years old, when he came to the United States in 1923. Before the days of Graduate Jewish Studies at American universities, Dropsie College in Philadelphia was one of the foremost institutions for scientific Jewish Studies education and research. Among its many distinguished students were Rabbi Dr. Bernard Revel, later President at RIETS, and Benzion Netanyahu (1910-2012), father of Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Paltiel, now Phillip Birnbaum received a Ph.D from Dropsie College. His dissertation, later published in 1942 was a critical edition of the Arabic commentary of the Karaite, Yefet Ben Ali, on the Book of Hosea. Birnbaum's edition included an English language introduction, a Hebrew translation of the Arabic original, and critical notes on the text.

By the 1930s, it was evident that Phillip Birnbaum was remarkably versatile in languages. His skill and passionate interest in the Hebrew language earned him a place on the board of the *Histadrut Ivrit b'America*, an organization for the promotion of Hebrew language and culture. He became a steady columnist and book reviewer for *Hadoar*, a Hebrew language periodical published by the *Histadruth Ivrit b'America*.

But his noteworthy talent and lasting contribution was in translation. He prepared translated anthologies of the Rambam's *Mishneh Torah* and *A Book of Jewish Concepts* (1975). But it was his well admired Hebrew-English versions of the *Machzor* (1945), *Ha-Siddur Ha-Shalem* (1949) a Pesach *Haggadah* (1953), and the *Five Megillot* (1973) which were widely recognized and commonly found in Orthodox, and many Conservative synagogues, throughout the Unites States and Canada. Philip Birnbaum died in 1988, at the age of 83.
