Be aware and find out eruv status every week before Shabbat and Chaggim. **Twitter:** Eruv's official alerts are sent out via Twitter.Follow @hp_eruv on Twitter Get updates about eruv's status as it's been determined. 'Text Messages: Don't have a Smartphone or don't want to use Twitter? Get alerts via text. This involves setting up a Twitter account, but once setup, you can ignore your Twitter account. It gives you immediate alerts without Twitter blather. •Facebook: Facebook group @hperuv that gets updated when we update Twitter account. Follow Facebook group (don't just "Like" it), and you'll get alerts about the eruv's status via Facebook. Email: Go to http://hperuv.org to sign up for email list. The email list checks the eruv's status after 3pm 1x hour and sends out emai updates. Eruv Webpage: The eruv webpage at <u>http://hperuv.org</u> has the latest Twitter feed displayed on the bottom of the front page. Webpage at <u>http://hperuv.org</u> with map of exact eruv boundaries, and where you need to be careful about staying inside eruv.
