CONGREGATION OHR TORAH NEW MASK POLICY

Based on the most recent updates to the CDC guidelines, this Friday Night, Ohr Torah will begin to offer two mask-optional minyanim (Main Shul and Social Hall.) Anyone choosing not to wear a mask at the mask-optional minyanim must be fully vaccinated.

Fully vaccinated is defined as fourteen days after receiving the second doseof the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or fourteen days after the single dose of J&J.

If you have not been fully vaccinated, you may attend the mask optional minyanim, but you must wear a mask at all times. The shul will also offer a mask-required minyanim in the YFM Room. If you are interested in the mask-required minyan please sign up here.

The sign up is needed in order to ensure that there is enough interest for a minyan.
