#### RABBI LUBAN'S SHABBOS SHUVA DRASHA

It is my pleasure to invite the congregation to my Shabbas Shuva drasha which will take place this Shabbos, September 11, at 6:50 PM. The drasha will be preceeded by Mincha at 6:30 PM.

The topic this year will be an analysis of the strange relationship between the great Tannaic scholar, Rebbe Mayer, and his teacher who became a heretic, Elisha Ben Avuyah, aka as Acher. By exploring this eerie episode, I hope to shed light on the complexity of the human condition, man's constant struggle between good and evil, and the powerful opportunity to return to Hashem through sincere acts of teshuva.
