### RPRY ANNOUNCEMENT

Rabbi Michael Ribalt has been appointed by the RPRY Board of Governors as Head of School, starting in mid-July. Rabbi Ribalt is eager to join the warm environment for which RPRY is known, and to lead students as they grow spiritually, academically and emotionally into Jews with deep connections to Hashem, His Torah, and Klal Yisrael.

Rabbi Ribalt has been at the Yeshiva of Central Queens (YCQ) since 2016, where he is Asst Principal of Judaic Studies, heading the elementary division grades 1-5, and focusing on curriculum planning in grades K-8. School Dir of Curriculum & Instruction and Educational Advancement & Technology at Manhattan Day School (MDS). He has also taught middle school and high school classes at SAR. At both MDS and SAR, Rabbi Ribalt worked to advance the respective yeshivot's use of educational technology.

Rabbi Ribalt lives in Clifton, NJ with his amazing wife, Rivka, and with their four beautiful children, Netanel, Noam, Moshe and Yehoshua.
