COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS TIKVA CHILDREN'S HOME

For 20+ years I have been privileged to sit on the Board of Tikva, a Jewish orphanage located in Odessa, Ukraine. I have traveled to Odessa over a dozen times, witnessing firsthand the aweinspiring work of Tikva that cares for homeless, abandoned and abused Jewish children in Odessa.

- ·2500 children have gone through the program since the year 2000;
- ·300 infants, toddler and teens are currently in the homes; and 600 children from local homes attend the school system Tikva built

It has been a difficult week and we anticipate that the coming weeks will not be any easier. We are engaged in an emergency fundraiser to cover everything from:

- ·Food and Basic Supplies (e.g., medications, emergency equipment – batteries, candles, torches, sleeping bags, etc.)
- Backup Communications (e.g., two way radios and satellite phones)
- 'Medical Equipment (e.g., defibrillators, first aid kits)
- Refrigerated Truck to keep meat and dairy supplies mobile generators
- An International Security Firm of private contractors to guide evacuations and offer physical security and support services on the ground We have already moved several hundred children to Moldova, which is further from the war zone right now. There are hundreds of more children that still need to be moved, and those that are unable to be moved and must be protected where they are.
