# **SHUL SECURITY**

As we approach the Yamim Nora'im we thought it would be an opportune time to update the membership on the steps we are taking to secure our members and our building.

The Security Committee, led by Marc Hanfling and Jonathan Teitelbaum (and including Leslie Ney, Matt Holland, Keith Peckman, Yoel Schwartz, Cliff Lacy and Roseanne Koenigson), met last Thursday night with myself and Rabbi Malitzky (Rabbi Luban had a conflict) to review and strengthen our security procedures and safety measures. I am happy to report that we will once again have an armed guard for the Yamim Nora'im. Further, we decided to have, as we have had in previous years prior to Covid, at least one member at all times outside during tefillah on Yamim Nora'im who is familiar with our membership and who can more easily spot a potentially dangerous person who does not belong. We are creating half hour slots per volunteer per day but require your participation. The safety

of our shul is extremely important and cannot be accomplished without your help. We urge you to volunteer 30 minutes of your time to further protect our family and friends. Please volunteer by signing up at <a href="https://www.ohrtorah.net/security.">https://www.ohrtorah.net/security.</a>
Second, the Security Committee and House Committee have been working diligently to implement the measures approved pursuant to our \$200,000 of combined Federal and State security grants. All of our proposed upgrades are expected to be completed by the first calendar quarter of 2023. The Security Committee also intends to schedule safety and fire drills in the shul during 2023

Third, the costs for securing our shul have grown substantially over the years and now roughly represent a \$25,000 annual cost (which is expected to grow further in coming years). Consistent with dozens of shuls in the tri-state area and beyond, the Board on this past Wednesday night voted to create an annual membership security fee for (A) full members at \$100 per couple and \$50 per single member and (B) \$25 per each associate member couple or \$12.50 per single member, to defray this expense, beginning 2023. The Board might have considered also raising the shul dues (which increase has not occurred in 14 years) but in light of the current economic environment such discussion was delayed until 2024. We wish you all a Shana tova u'metuka, a year filled with health, happiness, prosperity and safety.
