Greenwald Chair in Jewish Studies at Yeshiva University, where he has taught since 1983, and since 2020 has been teaching in the Tanach Track at the Stern College Graduate Program in Advanced Talmud Studies for Women program.

Rabbi Schwartz recently published Parashah Sheleimah: Bereishis by Mosaica Press. Rabbi Schwartz has also authored a scholarly edition of the Commentary of the Rokeach to the Book of Mishlei (Proverbs), as well as his Passover Haggadah - The 4 Sons Haggadah and has recently published "Conflict Resolutions in the Early Prophets".
