# THE ORTHODOX FORUM OF EDISON/HIGHLAND PARK

The Orthodox Forum of Edison/Highland Park presents Miriam Dobin, Author of "I am Because of You", Sat, Feb 11, 8pm at Congregation Etz Ahaim. Her mother, Olga was ten weeks shy of forty-eight years old when she was born and her father, Morris was fifty six. When she was a young child, her mother fell ill. Her aunt and uncle took her in and raised her as if she were their own. In essence, she had four parents. Upon the death of her beloved aunt, Miriam promised herself that the time had come to write the family history. Her task took her deep into the family records and halfway around the world to the places where her parents. grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins lived before they were imprisoned in Nazi concentration camps and where almost all of them were killed. In the summer of 2014, she and her husband went to the Auschwitz Concentration Camp. Afterwards, they went on to her parents' hometowns. There, they miraculously met a neighbor of her grandparents who lived there over eighty five years ago and still lives there today. She remembered everything in great detail.
