Update on Sabbath-Compliant Water Meters, in Borough of Highland Park Responding to helpful input from the VAAD HaRabbonim of Raritan Valley and the ROC of NJ, the Borough of Highland Park has arranged to accommodate the needs of hundreds of Jewish homeowners who have requested that the town provide 'Sabbathobservant' water meters, as part of this year's water meter replacement program. The Borough has placed an order for these new water meters and they hope to receive a sufficient quality within the next few months. These specialorder 'Sabbath-observant' meters will come at an added cost of \$10/meter, which will be charged to each consumer who requests them in their next quarterly water bill. In the interim, the Borough advises residents seeking the 'Sabbath-observant' water meters to refrain from scheduling a visit to
