RABBI'S CORNER

RECITING FALSEHOODS IN OUR PRAYERS AND BLESSINGS.

One of the additional blessings we recite in Bentching is הרחמן הוא ישלח ברכה מרובה בבית הזה ועל שלחן ישלח ברכה מרובה בבית הזה ועל שלחן (May Hashem send a large blessing to the this house and to this table that we ate on). Rav Yitzchak Zilberstein (Chasukei Chemed, Berachos 46a) writes that one who bentches at the beach or in a park without a table should instead recite הרחמן הוא ישלח ברכה (May Hashem send a blessing to our travels and to our sittings). To say "on this table" would be a falsehood.

In Selichos, we say "שחר"
"ישחר which refers to waking up at the crack of dawn. However, many of us will say Selichos well past the start of dawn. Rav Shlomo Zalman Auerbach (Halichos Shlomo, Rosh Hashana 1:3) is of the opinion that saying ישחר קמתי bis not a falsehood since it can also mean that I woke up earlier than usual. Similarly, he writes that we can say the prayers that mention Hashem hearing our cries even if we are not crying since we are referring to the collective cries of the Jewish people.
