### RABBI'S CORNER

While the Beracha of Hagomel can be recited anywhere, the custom is to recite it after reading from the Torah (Shulchan Aruch 219:3). The Eshel Avraham of Butshash (219:3) writes that if the one who recites the Beracha of Hagomel received an aliya, he should first recite the Beracha after his Aliya (Ashar Nasan Lanu Toras Emes) and then recite the Beracha of Hagomel. If he received the last aliya, the question arises whether the Hagomel should be recited immediately after the Aliya or after Kaddish. The Eshel Avraham points out that the custom is to say the Beracha of Hagomel prior to Kaddish being recited. He writes that while it would seem to be an interruption to say Hagomel between the Berachos and the Kaddish, nevertheless the custom is to say Hagomel first.
